- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL RESULTS

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF GMM Pfaudler Limited

- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of GMM Pfaudler Limited ("the Parent") and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 ("the Statement") being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of Parent's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, to the extent applicable.

- 4. The Statement includes the results of entities as given in Annexure to this report.
- 5. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.



6. We did not review the consolidated interim financial results of a subsidiary comprising 20 subsidiaries included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose consolidated interim financial results reflect total revenues of Rs. 568.13 Crore and Rs. 1,817.56 Crore for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 respectively, total net profit after tax of Rs. 16.36 Crore and Rs. 99.06 Crore for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 respectively and total comprehensive income of Rs. 17.94 Crore and Rs. 104.28 Crore for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 respectively, as considered in the Statement. These consolidated interim financial results have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

All of these subsidiaries are located outside India whose consolidated interim financial results have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries and which have been reviewed by other auditors under generally accepted auditing standards applicable in their respective countries. The Parent's management has converted the consolidated interim financial results of such subsidiaries located outside India from accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries to accounting principles generally accepted in India. We have reviewed these conversion adjustments made by the Parent's management. Our report on the statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries located outside India is based on the report of other auditors and the conversion adjustments prepared by the management of the Parent and reviewed by us.

Our Conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of these matters.

7. The consolidated unaudited financial results include the interim financial results of 1 subsidiary which has not been reviewed by its auditor, whose interim financial results reflect total revenues of Rs. 0.65 Crore and Rs. 1.97 Crore for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 respectively, total net loss after tax of Rs. 0.03 Crore and total net profit after tax of Rs. 0.64 Crore for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 respectively and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 0.03 Crore and total comprehensive income of Rs. 0.64 Crore for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 respectively, as considered in the Statement. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group.

Our Conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of our reliance on the interim financial results certified by the Management.

- 5) The Board of Directors of the Parent, pursuant to their meeting on February 02, 2023, granted approval for acquiring "Professional Mixing Equipment Inc. ("MixPro")" by way of acquisition of 100% share capital of its holding company 2012875 Ontario Inc. through its subsidiary company GMM Pfaudler US Inc. based in USA.

GMM Pfaudler US Inc. through a special purpose vehicle incorporated in Canada acquired MixPro. The acquisition price is USD 7 Million and the acquisition was completed on December 01, 2023.

The financial results of MixPro from the acquisition date to the reporting date does not have a material effect on the Consolidated unaudited financial results for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023.

6) The Group has presented net loss on restatement of foreign currency borrowings in "Other income" amounting to ₹ 11.45 crores and ₹ 18.46 crores for the quarter ended December 31, 2023 and December 31, 2022 respectively.
