Kolkata: Cables and air-conditioner manufacturer Havells India on Monday announced a 14% year-on-year (yoy) drop in its standalone net profit at ₹352 crore for the first quarter ending June, with net sales taking at a hit by 6% year-on-year at 65,438 crore due to a weak summer which impacted sales of the company's air-conditioners, fans and air-coolers.

The company's chairman and managing director Anil Rai Gupta told analysts in its quarterly earnings call there is high channel inventory for ACs which will take 1-2 quarters to liquidate and the company is accordingly adjusting production. KIIT Suicides Due to 'Unlawful' Activity of Univ, says UGC Panel

New Delhi: The illegal and unlawful activities by Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KI-IT) in Bhubaneswar led to the suicides of two Nepalese students and the actions of the administration amount to criminal liability, a fact-finding panel set up the UGC has found. The panel said that the "suicide could have been averted". The panel was constituted in May by the UGC after a 20-year-old Ne palese student of KIIT was found hanging from the ceiling fan of her hostel room. The incident took place after the suicide of Prakriti Lamsal, another Nepalese student of the same institute, on February 16. "The university's ICC failed to take lawful action in reported sexual harassment cases. There was no transparency that the protocols for the investigation were followed. The girl had made complaints to the administration twice, much before this tragic incident. In both complaints, they decided to go for an illegal compromise. - PTI




